

**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING
OF THE
WINSLOW UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1
GOVERNING BOARD**

CALL TO ORDER: The public hearing of the Governing Board of Winslow Unified School District No. 1 was called to order by Mrs. Marilee Ervien, President, at 5:45 p.m. on October 19, 2017, in the District Board/Conference Room, 800 Apache Ave., Second Floor, Winslow, Arizona.

- II. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- III. Review the 2017-18 Revised Adopted Annual District-Wide Expenditure Budget No. 1 for Winslow Unified School District No. 1

Mrs. Shirley Lomeli, Business Manager, addressed the Board. She said that state statute requires this revision to be done by November 1st and that the main reason for the timing is the 1.06% teacher salary increase. Additionally, she has revised all the budget figures to reflect the reductions due to current year funding on reduced student enrollment counts and carry forward amounts from last year's budget. Maintenance and Operations has been reduced by \$356,032 and Unrestricted Capital has been reduced by \$79,099.

She asked if anyone had any questions. There were none.

- IV. Review information regarding the 1.06% Teacher Salary Increase pursuant to Laws 2017, Ch. 305, § 33.

Mrs. Lomeli reviewed information regarding the 1.06% teacher salary increase. She explained the process to figure eligibility. The increases vary from approximately \$360 to \$650, depending on each teacher's existing salary. The increase is based only on certain pay categories and only certified teachers will receive it.

Mrs. Lomeli said that December 8 has been proposed as the date to pay this money. Usually teachers receive classroom site funds at that time, but those were paid in August to help employees due to the delayed pay schedule this year. She added that the legislature has enacted that it be paid next year as well.

VI. Adjournment

Mrs. Greenwood made a motion, which was seconded by Mr. Hartnett, to adjourn the meeting. All members voted "aye". Motion carried at 5:52 p.m.
