

## Junior Project Poster Board Presentation Requirements

- All juniors **MUST** have a junior project on display at the MASA Banquet on May 21, 2018
- Projects must be set – up by 4:00pm for judging. The public can view the projects starting at 5:30pm
- At least one member of each group **MUST** be present with the project from 4:00 – 6:00pm.
- Your project **MUST** be on a professional looking poster-board that includes:
  - The title of your project
  - Project Goals
  - A synopsis of your project
  - Why you chose this project
  - Timeline of when every aspect of your project was completed ***Looking for project information---meetings, tours, practices, etc. How much time spent on project?***
  - Pictures documenting the entire project
  - Results/What you learned
  - A Written Reflection that answers this question:  
***What did you discover about yourself as a learner from working on this project? Reflect on your work from this project providing specific examples of your experiences with details from this project to support your conclusions about problem solving, personal growth, new skills acquired and how this fits into your future plans.***

Remember that this is a **PROFESSIONAL** presentation. You may be asked questions by the judges, but the main judging will be done based on what you put on your poster-board...so make sure your project is clearly stated, neatly done, and that the judges can tell from your poster exactly what you did. This is your time to show - off what you have accomplished this year!
