**Information Items:**

- Dr. Hobbs discussed the budget with the Board. He informed the Board that the county manager had released the proposed local budget and had developed a purpose/function budget for education. He also stated he apologized if people had been worried about

jobs; however, his priority since coming to Yadkin County Schools was to “right-size” the ship and that the list of budget cuts he presented to the Board were only “options” as nothing had been approved by the Board of Education. He also stated there were less central office positions now than we he came two years ago and that the proposed county budget eliminated the Human Resources Director and Exceptional Director positions. Lynn Allred asked what the impact of losing these two positions would be. Dr. Hobbs stated that he has been to court twice and one was over personnel and the other exceptional children. Dr. Allred asked if we could pay for the EC position with federal funds and Dr. Hobbs stated no that this would be considered supplanting. There was also discussion that the county budget included a 1% supplement increase for teachers, principals, assistant principals and high school coaches. Dr. Hobbs stated he was glad that these employees were receiving an increase; however, it concerned him that all employees would not be receiving this. In addition, the Board expressed concern that all employees were not included in this increase.

- Dr. Hobbs recommended to the Board that the Chair and Vice-Chair meet with the Commissioner Chair. He stated we have had a great relationship and hope that we can continue. Howard McKnight stated we are definitely at a tough point and he and Joe Dezern will meet with Kevin Austin and David Welborn.
- Diane Hampton thanked Dr. Hobbs for his service to the students of Yadkin County Schools.
