

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

HEALTH EDUCATION/STUDENT EXCLUSION

PURPOSE:

This regulation is established to set forth Administrative Regulations regarding the implementation of School Committee Policy IHAM that permits the exclusion of certain students from health education classes offered by the North Kingstown School District.

REGULATIONS:

Students who are to be excluded from health education shall be required to submit to alternate instructional opportunities as stated here within:

Elementary Schools

Students excluded from health instruction will be expected to fulfill an independent assignment from the classroom teacher.

Middle Schools

Students who are excluded from health class will be expected to meet the following requirements:

- a. Each quarter of exclusion the student must read two books on a health-related topic. These books will be selected by the parent and child and approved by the health teacher. The student will write a report on each book.
- b. Students will also be required to complete a project to consist of a written report on a health-related topic. This topic will also be selected by the parent and child and approved by the health teacher.
- c. The health teacher will evaluate all reports and determine the student's grade in health.

High School

Students excluded from health instruction will choose an alternate health project .
