

Old Village School Features

The Main Street facility (formerly Main Street Elementary School) and the adjacent Old Village School (OVS) are the district's two oldest buildings. Old Village was mothballed in 2012 and the Main Street facility currently houses Early Childhood classrooms and the district's central office function. The relocation from Main Street to OVS offers a number of efficiencies.

- Preserves Old Village School's rich history as part of Northville Public Schools and the entire Northville community
- Growth potential (additional 4-5 classrooms) for Early Childhood's popular downtown location.
- Flexibility to relocate Early Childhood classroom to Old Village School from elementary schools where enrollment growth is straining building capacity
- Creation of an interior recreational space for Early Childhood classes
- Central Office space configuration that is conducive to a collaborative work environment
- Secure entrances for Early Childhood classrooms and Central Office
