In accordance with State Bylaw Article 2, §222, St. Francis High School has an open enrollment policy. St. Francis High School does not discriminate against any applicant because of race, religion, or national origin in conformity with Christian charity and the Civil Rights Act of 1964. It admits students of any race, color, racial or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available for all students at the school. The School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, racial or ethnic origin in the admission of its educational policies, scholarships and loan programs, or other school programs. St. Francis High School seeks to admit students who wish to excel academically, socially, and spiritually.

It is in keeping with the school's high academic and moral standards that we ask students to complete the requirements upon seeking admission to the school. The specialized nature of the academic program (college preparatory) at St. Francis makes it impossible to accept every candidate for admission. Experience has shown the best criteria for the selection of students to consist in a COMBINATION of the following listed below.

St. Francis High School offers a challenging college preparatory curriculum and has high expectations regarding the character of its students. Our experience has shown the best criteria for the selection of students to consist of a combination of the following: standardized test scores (including the entrance examination); transcript (including behavior and attendance records); confidential teacher recommendations; and a family interview.

In general, to be admitted, students should have satisfactory academic grades, a good record of conduct and effort, grade-level standardized test scores, and positive teacher/school recommendations.

St. Francis High School offers only one test date: January 20, 2018. The test begins at 8:30 am and will end approximately at noon. There is an essay portion to this test that may not be required at other sites.

Admissions process: (Family Responsibility)

- Submit a completed application and application fee (\$75) no later than January 20, 2018;
- If an application is accepted after January 20th, it is subject to a \$25 late fee;
- Take an entrance examination (STS/HSPT). If a student does not take the exam at St. Francis, it is the family's responsibility to have the results forwarded by the testing site to St. Francis as soon as possible after the examination;
- If Catholic, have the Pastor Recommendation Form sent to the Office of the Registrar;
- Complete an interview (the student and at least one parent) on February 3, 2018;
- Letters of recommendation are not necessary nor do we provide forms, but a maximum of three may be submitted.

Admissions Process: (St. Francis Responsibility)

- We will request official transcripts from the student's current school after the entrance examination;
- We will forward confidential rating forms (for recommendation) to the student's current school;
- We will confirm the student's appointment time and location for an interview by mail during the week of January 29th.
- We will send notification of admission on March 2, 2018, provided all the requested information is received in a timely fashion.
