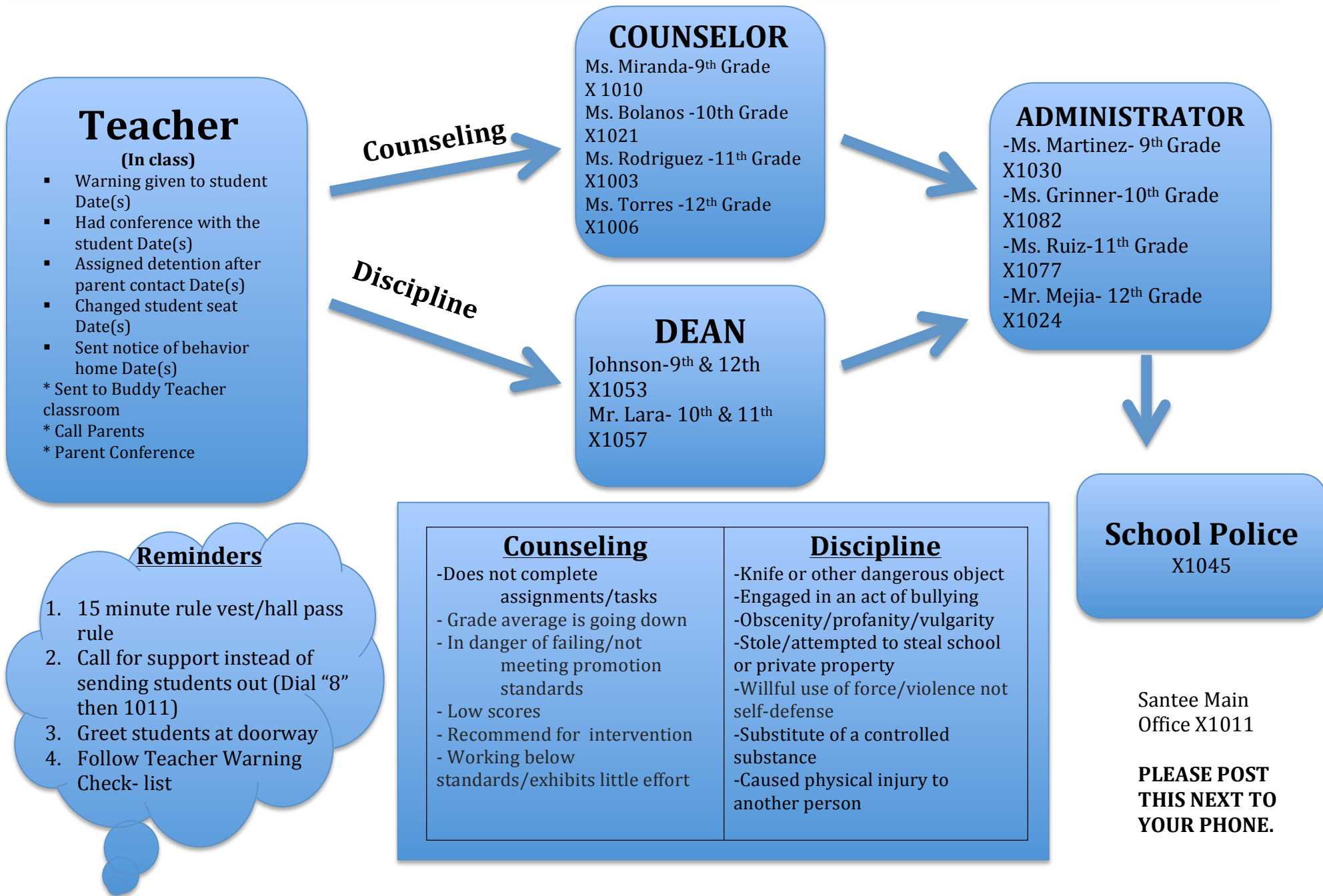


Santee's Progressive Intervention Plan Flow Chart

Reminders

- Does not complete assignments/tasks
- Grade average is going down
- In danger of failing/not meeting promotion standards
- Low scores
- Recommend for intervention
- Working below standards/exhibits little effort

Discipline

- Knife or other dangerous object
- Engaged in an act of bullying
- Obscenity/profanity/vulgarity
- Stole/attempted to steal school or private property
- Willful use of force/violence not self-defense
- Substitute of a controlled substance
- Caused physical injury to another person
