Bus Rider Guidelines

Following these guidelines listed below will help to ensure that transporting your students is made as safe as possible. In the event that these expectations are not met, the student or students not complying will be appropriately disciplined. Discipline may include temporary suspension of riding privileges. If a student continually fails to follow these guidelines, he or she may lose riding privileges permanently. 1. Students need to stay in their assigned seats anytime the bus is in motion.
2. Students should talk in an appropriate manner –
 - a. No yelling or screaming
 - b. No profanity
 - c. No loud talking or inappropriate noises
 - d. Quietly talk to the person sitting next to you
3. Food and drink will continue to be allowed as long as:
 - a. The bus is kept clean
 - b. There is no throwing of food or drinks
 - c. There is no fighting over food or drink.
4. There should be no toys, balls, or other similar items brought on the bus unless they are stowed away in backpacks.
5. Electronic devices may be used but the volume needs to be kept low and the brightness cannot distract the driver
6. Please let the driver know as soon as possible if the student is not riding the bus.
