Reports from Superintendent and Leadership Team

The Board adopted the 2017-2018 School calendar.

Superintendent Robey shared his long-range plan for the Middle School Task Force. It will be a committee made up of administrators, teachers, parents (both elementary and middle school), representatives from GEHS and team leaders from GWMS. They will meet once a month.

The Board approved Madison School's 5K Walk pending Village of Lombard approval.

Finance and Facilities

Assistant Superintendent Ted Stec is currently putting together the transportation bid specs with the help of CASE and District 87. We are looking to go out to bid as soon as possible.

We are back on track with Fairwood's demolition. Weather has been favorable of late and we are now ahead of schedule, ready to deliver the land to the Park District on February 1.

Teaching and Learning

Assistant Superintendent for Teaching and Learning, Annetta Spsychalski and Assistant Superintendent Stec will be visiting two schools that have redesigned their science labs.

Due to the DuPage Foundations, JCS Fund, on January 24 the Alliance Brass Clinic will be working with our 4-6th grade band students after school. Dr. Elizabeth Peterson from University of Illinois visited the Willdcat Band rehearsal in November and will be returning on February 3rd.

Special Services

Director of Special Services, Kari Smith shared that planning has begun for the March 3rd Districtwide Institute Day. The CASE EC Collaborative exploration team will be holding a community partnership meeting on January 31st.
