Approval of agenda	I/D/A	The agenda for meeting will be reviewed and approved. Agenda and minutes from last meeting were reviewed and approved.	Group	5 min
Dress code issues	I/D/A	KMS dress code discussion. The agreed upon changes to the dress code: (1) ripped jeans will be allowed as long as tears are below the mid-thigh; (2) shorts must be at mid-thigh or longer; (3) leggings must be worn with blouses or shirts of mid-thigh length or longer; (4) razorback tops will be allowed as long as no cleavage or undergarments are visible. (Proper undergarments to include bandeaus, strapless bras, tank tops). Blouses/dresses with spaghetti straps will not be addressed at this time. Therefore, the rule for at least 1" straps is still in effect as part of the dress code. Student reps have agreed to bring examples of allowed/not allowed garments when the new dress code is introduced to the student body in January.	Group	20 min
Budget 2017-18	I/D	Preview of KMS 2017-2018 Budget. The 2017-2018 budget was reviewed with no major issues brought up. Clarifications explained by Mr. Brown: personnel dollar amounts reflect what is charged to the school and not necessarily how much personnel is paid, substitute days and other miscellaneous amounts are cushioned to accommodate minor changes in student enrollment, the goal for computer purchases are at about 25/teacher, subscriptions include programs such as Achieve 3000, PD includes paying for speakers/professional consultants to support our teachers' goals. Carryovers of the budget are put towards items such as computers, fans, smartboards, and science materials. It was explained that money for sports equipment is covered by the PE teachers as part of their annual budget for classroom supplies. It was also explained that purchasing and installing A/C units would require some structural changes to the building (for example, to the louver-style windows) in order to accommodate A/C units in the classrooms. Mr. Brown also explained there is a Title 1 budget not reflected in this plan that is set aside for the Remedial Math teacher position and also contracted consultation services.	Group	20 Min
