- Local School Bond

Dr. Ferguson stated that the issue before the Board today is that the Order of Election has to be passed by the Board for the bond to be placed on the ballot.

Board Member Bailey stated that what is important is what direction the District is going with the bond and what needs to be done. In light of the short timeline to election day, he suggested that the Board look at placing the bond on the November 2003 general election ballot.
