GHS Prom Candidate Campaign Rules and Important Dates

Campaign Rules:

1. You may post 10 – 3’x5’ campaigning posters.
 - Ms. Rosales must approve posters before posting them or they will be removed and you will be disqualified. You will be able to start campaigning on **May 2nd - 18th, 2018**. Last day to get campaigning posters approved by Ms. Rosales will be **Friday, May 11th, 2018 by the end of the school day**.
 - **ONLY** Poster Paper will be provided by ASB. You must provide your own paint and brushes.
 - No foul language or negative campaigning will be allowed.
 - If any negative campaigning is reported, the candidate involved will face disqualification.
 - If a candidate is seen or suspected of destroying another candidate’s campaign materials, the candidate will be disqualified.
 - NO advertising inside ANY building.
 - ALL campaigning posters must be taken down by 3:00 pm on **Friday, May 18th, 2018** or the candidate will be disqualified.
2. Flashcards
 - Flashcards must be hand made, written or computer generated.
 - Flashcards must be worn or attached with curling ribbon or yarn.
 - No stickers or labels.
 - No bribes, gifts, buttons, etc.
3. NO promoting yourself or others on social media..
