Test Requirements

- Government issued photo ID: Drivers license, Department of Public Safety identification card, military ID, passport, martricula consula
- Provide proof of residency in Texas: TX driver license, utility bill showing TX address, or bank statement with TX address
- 18 years of age
- Not enrolled in an accredited high school

Score Requirements

To earn a State of TX Certificate of High School Equivalency, you must achieve a *minimum of 150 on each of the four exams*. Scores of 170-200 represent performance consistent with college and career readiness.

Test scores prior to January 1, 2014 are no longer valid.

What's on the test?

Reasoning through Language Arts test – 150 minutes

- Section 1 – 35 minutes tests all content
- Section 2 – 45 minutes is the Extended Response portion of the test
- Section 3 – 60 minutes tests all content

Mathematical Reasoning Test – 115 minutes

- Part 1 – first 5 test questions calculator is not allowed
- Part 2 - remaining 41 questions calculator is allowed

Social Studies Test – 90 minutes

- Section 1 – 65 minutes tests all content
- Section 2 – 25 minutes is the Extended Response portion

Science Test – 90 minutes

- One section
- 2 short answers: students are expected to manage their time and spend about 10 minutes on each question
